EuroHockey supports the IOC gender standards and recommendations for gender balance.

Each member national association is recommended to adopt the charter for gender balance.

EuroHockey will work with all national associations to develop a strategic long-term approach that is unique for each association, to work towards and maintain gender balance opportunities across the European hockey family.







EXPLAINING THE AREAS OF IMPLEMENTATION

I. Gender balance in leadership positions explained

Sports federations are continuing to mature as businesses and good governance is of upmost importance. This presents gender balance opportunities for member national associations.

EuroHockey entrusts member national associations to take the courageous step to consider if they have a pathway for all people to be elected to their Executive Boards no matter their gender.

2. Gender balance across participation explained

European hockey gender balance is different across each area of the game. Whether this is playing, coaching, officiating or volunteering there is a range of different gender balances across the member national associations in Europe.

EuroHockey entrust member national associations to take the courageous step to consider if they have a pathway for all people to reach each area of the game so that we maximise ways to increase participation in hockey at every level.
